1. The above particulars must be clearly and correctly provided. Any incomplete and/or wrong entries may be rejected at the discretion of Cat Welfare Society.
2. Each caregiver is limited to 5 cats and out of which only 2 female cats are allowed.
3. All cats must be ear tipped without exception.
4. Caregivers are not allowed to choose which clinic to sent the cats to.
5. Cats shall not be given any food and water from 10pm onwards the night before the Spay Day.
6. Cats will be rejected if food and/or water are found in the carriers or traps.
7. Cats must be sent to the selected Drop Off Point on Spay Day not later than 8.30am. Any cats send in after 8.30am will be rejected for sterilisation on Spay Day.
8. Cats must be placed in proper carriers or traps. Cats that are not in proper carriers or traps will be rejected.
9. Cats must be picked up at the selected Drop Off Points by 8.30pm. A penalty of \$100 will be imposed if cats are picked up after 8.30pm.
10. Female cats have to be kept by the caregivers for at least 48 hours or until they are fully recovered before they can be released back to the community.
11. Male cats have to be kept by the caregivers for at least 24 hours or until they are fully recovered before they can be released back to the community.
12. There are inherent risks in any surgical procedure and caregivers must accept that infections, sickness and even death, may occur despite the good faith of the clinic or hospital involved. The above risks may be greater for stray cats who are stressed from the ordeal of being trapped and then placed in enclosed and strange environment. Cat Welfare Society and the clinic or hospital shall not be responsible for any inherent risks arising from these surgical procedures.
13. The venue of the Drop Off Point may be subjected to change at the discretion of Cat Welfare Society.
14. As there are limited sterilisation slots available on Spay Day, application shall be on a first come first serve basis.
